


Review of Session 6



I - Intended to Rule in Faithfulness


Genesis 1:26, 28 Revelation 22:4-5

- Learn about the invisible landscape of His Kingdom through faithfulness in the small things. (108) [Two Kingdom secrets: invisible & small]

Hiding from God • Misjudging God's Goodness • Fearful



If we are to grow spiritually, we have to understand that we already are in charge of some things. So find out what you have say over and use it to become the kind of person who can manage ten cities. The physical universe isn't going to disappear; it's here to stay. And there will always be a need for people to supervise it. We were made to be in charge.

III - The Unjust Steward - Luke 16:1-12


Let's make a deal with those indebted to the master.

Being shrewd with all things under the rule of God means making judgments about what is good and what is not.

What is important is the faithfulness, not the size of what's going on. (117)

What God is going to get out of my life, whatever I may do otherwise, is the person I become.

IV - Investing My Kingdom (118-120)

Mastering My Minas to become the Messiah's Mayor What is in your Kingdom? This is what I'm in charge of!

- 1.) You are in charge of certain aspects of your life.

 Too many distractions. What are crucial things?
- 2.) Be intentional and definite about what you want to see happen.
- 3.) Make sure your desired outcomes are of God.

Evidence of the presence of the Spirit of God is the incommensurability of the outcome* with the effort. When you see that tremendous difference in outcome, you know that God is on the scene. That is what we really have to do to cultivate* the Kingdom of God in our lives.



MEANS - What calling/vision is on my heart that I will share this week?






