





Session 2 Review

Jesus knew how to provide a morality that would actually make people good, and He could enable people to do it.

We need to shift Jesus from "nice" to the One with the most essential knowledge of the most important aspects for a life well lived!

Life's Four Great Questions

- 1.) What is the nature of reality?
- 2.) Who is well off?
- 3.) Who is a really good person?
- 4.) How do you become a really good person?

In memory of Dallas Willard

September 4, 1935 - May 8, 2013

Beloved Professor of Philosophy (1965-2012)

"You cannot 'opt out' of having a worldview.
You can only try to have one that most accords with reality, including the whole realm of facts concerning what is genuinely good.
The four questions any worldview must answer are:

What is reality?
Who is well-off?
Who is truly a good person?
How does one become a truly good person?

"4M IQ" — Life's Four Most Important Questions

- Q1 What is reality?
- A The Kingdom of God.
 - "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand."
- Q2 Who is well off living the good life?
- A Living in the direct availability of the Kingdom of God. "Blessed are the _____, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven."
- Q3 Who is a good person?
- A One permeated with agape love.
 - "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."
- Q4 How do I become a good person?
- A Become an apprentice of Jesus.
- "Everyone who hears my words and puts them into practice is like a

wise man..."

Socrates knew that people had to come to truth they could live by of their own initiative. One reason why he had confidence he could work with truth as he did because he believed there was a God who spoke to him and guided him.



Is there Human Nature?

"Any system of education that ignores the moral and religious nature of the student is fundamentally defective."

Ohio State University President, 1882


Sometimes a nature surprises us.

What is it to have a Human Nature?

"A human nature has parts with specific properties that constitute the whole person in such a way that its peculiar wholeness provides a standard for what a human being is and provides norms for how a person is to be treated and what they are to do."

PLATO'S REPUBLIC - THREE HUMAN PARTS: REASON, EMOTION & APPETITE

EMOTION GUIDED BY REASON MUST DIRECT THE APPETITES TO THEIR PROPER EXERCISE IN THE INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIETY.



Desire - Appetite Addiction - Democracy - Tyranny

Moral Knowledge Disappeared from Our Present World

- -> Six Rumors of Moral Knowledge <-
- 1.) "Morality is relative."
- 2.) "Only sense perceptible is knowable." (not will, character)
- 3.) "Only the measure of all is known."
- 4.) "Moral truth suppresses freedom and diversity."
- 5.) "Everyone do what they want as long as nobody gets hurt."
- 6.) "Profound changes in the University."

These profound changes are all tied to the denial of human nature.

The Outcome

```
Political Correctness — No human nature leaves power, will, desire.
```

Politics and law rule. Politics rules law.

Pleasure will be king.

Romans 1 — Therefore God gave them...
...up to vile impurity in the lusts of their hearts (v. 24)
...over to degrading passions (v. 26)
...to a depraved mind (v. 28)
